This laboratory complements the BIOL 265 lecture by providing students with hands-on experiences such as examination of preserved specimens and anatomical models and performing physiological experiments. Topics covered in the Human Anatomy & Physiology II Laboratory include: the anatomy and physiology of the immune system, lymphatic system, cardiovascular system, respiratory system, digestive system, urinary system, and reproductive system.
