First semester of a two-semester sequence in the senior year. The clinical year is a 12-month training period typically beginning in July, but varying among programs. The clinical training program is conducted by an affiliated hospital; grading is only pass/no credit, and hospital officials are the sole arbiters of these grades. **Credits:** 15
