NUR 890: NURSE ANESTHESIOLOGY PRAC COMP I

This is the first in a series of courses designed to integrate knowledge and clinical correlation of advanced physiology/pathophysiology, advanced pharmacology, and basic and advanced principles of nurse anesthesia.
