ENG 400: MAJOR SEMINAR (M)

Students will learn about and evaluate the various theoretical approaches that may be used to analyze literary texts. Once this proposal is approved, they will write a research paper of 5,000-6,000 words (excluding notes and bibliography), culminating in a formal presentation and defense.
